Neil Tunison, County Engineer, was present at the request of the Board to explain the easement agreement with Timothy Patton for the SR 73 & Township Line Road intersection project listed on the consent agenda.

Mr. Tunison stated that there have been numerous project completed surround this intersection and this is the final portion to complete the updates. He stated that there were several fatalities in the 1990's in the area which brought about the necessity for this series of improvements.

The Board stated their concern relative to the cost of \$102,000 for the easements.

Mr. Tunison stated that this is commercial property and the proposed elevation of the roadway adjacent to this project requires the acquisition of a large portion of the business' driveway.
