PUBLIC HEARING

CALENDAR YEAR 2010 TRANSIT GRANT APPLICATION

The public hearing to consider the CY 2010 Transit Grant application was convened this 8^{th} day of September 2009, in the Commissioners' Meeting Room.

Jerry Haddix, Grants Coordinator, stated that the proposed operating amount of 2010 is \$1,462,125 which is a 2.6% increase over 2009. He stated that the local cash match is estimated at \$434,892 which is down from \$543,712 for 2009. He then stated that in 2010, we begin to have to maintenance portion of the operating cost reimbursed at a rate of 80% rather that 50%. He stated that the capital purchases program of the grant application allows for the replacement of three (3) light transit vehicles with the 10% local share proposed at \$14,369.00

Upon further discussion the Board closed the public hearing and resolved (Resolution #09-1214) to authorize the submittal of the 2010 Transit Grant application.

On motion, upon unanimous call of the roll, the Board entered into executive session at 10:40 a.m. to discuss matters required to be kept confidential per Federal or State Law pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22 (G)(6) and exited at 11:42 a.m.
