Commissioner Young led those present in prayer in support of the families that lost loved ones and their livelihood in the barn fire at the Warren County Fairgrounds over the weekend.

Rodney Fields, Turtlecreek Township resident, was present to discuss his issue with the Water and Sewer Department relative to fees to connect to the waterline in front of his home.

Mr. Fields stated that he has adjacent to his property a waterline from Warren County as well as Cincinnati Water Works (City of Mason water). He stated that he called the Warren County Water Department to obtain information on cost to connect to Warren County's waterline. He was informed that the cost would be \$2,030.00. He then came into the Water Department office and paid cash for the amount he was quoted.

Upon review of the records from the Business Manager and Office Administrator, it was determined that Mr. Fields was not included in the assessment project which constructed the line in front of his property due to the existing pre-annexation agreement with the City of Mason and therefore, he will be required to pay an additional \$5,800.00 prior to connecting to the Warren County's waterline.

Mr. Fields stated that, had he known the actual cost to connect to Warren County's line, he would have chosen to connect to Cincinnati Water Works at a cost of approximately \$4,000.00.

Upon discussion, the Board agreement to allow him to connect to Warren County's line at the same cost as Cincinnati Water Works and requested staff to confirm cost with Cincinnati Water Works and prepare a resolution relative to their decision for adoption upon confirmation of actual costs.

Ramona Kaleen, Peck Shaffer & Williams, was present to discuss the Agreement in connection with the Issuance of Port Authority Revenue Bonds of the Dayton-Montgomery County Port Authority relative to Goodwill/Easter Seals construction of a store adjacent to Walmart in the City of Lebanon.

Ms. Kaleen explained that approval in required from Warren County since one of the stores being constructed is within the county.

Lance Detriech, Goodwill/Easter Seals, presented information relative to the Goodwill Company as well as a rendering of the proposed store.
