DISCUSSIONS

The Board met this 16th day of November 2010, to further consider the site plan review application of Landtech/CelluSite LLC and Emmor T. Baily for the construction of a telecommunications tower in Turtlecreek Township.

Mike Yetter, Zoning Supervisor, explained to the Board that the Prosecutor's Office has determined that the Zoning Board of Appeals does not have the authority to consider a setback variance relative to telecommunications towers per the Warren County Rural Zoning Code.

The Board stated their concern relative to the approval of the site plan review stating it could be problematic in setting a precedent for future site plan review.

Derick McGrew, Landtech/CelluSite LLC representative, stated that the Warren County Rural Zoning Code relative to telecommunications towers is outdated relative to setback requirements for self-supporting towers. He then stated the opinion of their legal counsel that the section of the Warren County Rural Zoning Code that states the Zoning Board of Appeals does not have the authority to grant a variance relative to setback requirements for telecommunications towers is not legal. He then presented to the Board the most up to date technical specifications relative to tower failures.

There was much discussion relative to the desire of the Board to update the section of the Rural Zoning Code relative to telecommunications towers.

Matt Nolan, Assistant Prosecutor, stated his recommendation to deny this site plan review applications due to non-compliance with the Warren County Rural Zoning Code.

Upon discussion, the Board resolved (Resolution #10-1673) to deny the site plan review application and refund the application fee.

Upon further discussion, the Board requested the Zoning Supervisor work with the Regional Planning Commission to present a text amendment to address the outdated section of the Zoning Code relative to telecommunications towers.

On motion, upon unanimous call of the roll, the Board accepted and approved the consent agenda.					
Michael Scheppers, Warren County United Way, was present along with staff and representatives from the Lebanon Food Pantry and members of the Lebanon Area Young Professionals for the proclamation to begin the 5 th Annual Food Drive Challenge in Warren County.					
There was discussion relative to the greater need for donations relative to the economy and the Board stated their desire to donate \$30,000 towards the \$65,000 shortfall from last years food drive. The Board also issued a challenge to area businesses to help cover the remaining shortfall of \$35,000.					
On motion, upon unanimous call of the roll, the Board entered into executive session at 10:20 a.m. to discuss union negotiations pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22 (G)(4) and exited at 12:23 p.m.					
The Board conducted a budget work session relative to the 2011 appropriations with Tiffany Zindel, Director of OMB.					
There was discussion relative to the appropriation adjustment necessary to accommodate the sick					
and vacation payout for two employees who recently retired and was re-hired. The Board stated their desire to for the County Administrator to request a Prosecutor's opinion					
relative to the hire dates and the effect if has on the unused sick and vacation time payout.
