Tom Rockwood, Athletes in Action, was present for the Board to proclaim May 5, 2011, as "Night of Champions Day" in Warren County.

Mr. and Mrs. Weber, Foster-Maineville Road, Hamilton Township, was present to discuss their concern relative to the road right-of-way adjacent to their property not being correct.

Mr. Weber stated that Duke and the County Engineer are claiming a road right-of-way that is too expansive for their property and includes their well. He stated that he has contacted the County Engineer several times but did not get a return telephone call. He then stated he did receive a letter from Mr. Tunison relative to the question.

Mr. Weber then stated he done some title research in the County Recorder's Office and found in 1954 where his ancestor grounded a ten foot easement to Cincinnati Gas & Electric (CG & E) which would be a grand total of a 15 foot easement, not the thirty foot that CG & E is claiming. He then requested the Board's assistance in his attempt to regain possession of his well.

Upon discussion, the Board requested Mr. Weber to send his request in writing in order for the Board to forward his request to the County Engineer and County Prosecutor for assistance.
