DISCUSSIONS

On motion, upon unanimous call of the roll, the Board accepted and approved the consent agenda.

Tom Britton, President of the Veterans' Service Commission, was present along with other members and Rodney Eversole, Executive Director, and Nick Nelson, County Auditor, to discuss their budget request increase for 2014 due to the outreach program they will implement in 2014.

Mr. Britton explained that the original budget request submitted was \$1,822,500 and they have revised the amount to \$2,177,973 which is within the amount allocated to the Veterans through the Ohio Revised Code.

Mr. Nelson stated that the amount they are entitled to, based upon the entitlement of five-tenths of a mill per dollar on the assessed value of the property of the county, is \$2.77 million.

There was discussion relative to what authority a Board of Commissioners has when it comes to appropriation vs. oversight of how the funds are spent. Keith Anderson, Assistant Prosecutor, stated he will research the question and provide his findings at a later date.

There was discussion relative to the change in philosophy of the Veterans' Services from "we are here to help, come see us if you need anything" to going to find veterans and see what assistance they need.

Mr. Britton stated that they served 892 veterans in 2012 with relief funds and that number is down for 2013. He also stated that Warren County has a denial rate of only 4% vs. Butler County's denial rate of 39%.

The Board questioned what the Veterans Services intended to do with the addition \$580,000.

Mr. Eversole stated that half of the funds are allocated to the cost of the bus intended to allow them to provide outreach services including awareness and education with the remainder proposed for staff increases.

There was discussion relative to the need for additional space.

Upon discussion, the Board requested staff to inform Mr. Shadoan to accommodate the space request.

On motion, upon unanimous call of the roll, the Board entered into executive session at 9:59 a.m. to discuss matters required to be kept confidential per federal or state law (HIPAA) pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22 (G)(5) and union negotiation pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22 (G)(4) relative to the Sheriff's Office and exited at 11:15 a.m.
