### DESIGNATE PROJECTS WARREN COUNTY INTENDS TO FUND FOR THE FY 2017 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) URBAN ENTITLEMENT PROGRAM

The second public hearing to consider the designation of projects for FY 2017 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Urban Entitlement Program was convened this 18<sup>th</sup> day of April 2017 in the Commissioners Meeting Room.

Susanne Mason, Program Manager, reviewed the following selected projects:

\$ 19,145	Village of Butlerville – Playground Upgrade
\$ 60,000	Deerfield Twp – Davis/Rich Rd Engineering
\$160,000	Franklin Township - Harriet-Olive-Mentz Road Project
\$277,900	City of Lebanon - Cambridge-Georgetown-Raintree-Winding Way Project
\$ 64,500	Interfaith Hospitality Network – Assistance to Homeless
\$ 42,000	Abuse & Rape Crisis Shelter – Housing Assistance to Domestic Victims
\$ 90,000	Administrative Costs

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Mrs. Mason explained that a decision has not been made relative to the final allocation of federal funds; therefore, they cannot proceed with application submittal until final allocation is determined.

There was discussion relative to the question of the continuation of community development block grant funds in the current federal administration.

Upon further discussion, the public hearing was closed.
