## **DISCUSSIONS**

On motion, upon unanimous call of the roll, the Board accepted and approved the consent agenda.

Neil Tunison, County Engineer, was present along with Kurt Weber, Chief Deputy Engineer, Chuck Petty, Assistant Engineer, Stephanie Roeder, Red Lion Five Points Road resident and various other residents from the Bunnell Hill/Lytle Five Points/Red Lion Five Points area to discuss the proposed roadway improvements.

Mr. Weber reviewed the proposed project and discussed the desire of Mrs. Roeder to demolish the existing house that was purchased by the County in order to relocate the roadway in that location.

There was discussion relative to the Engineer's concern relative to the additional right of way needed from the adjacent property in order to accommodate the request as well as the current alignment being strategically placed in order to prevent headlights from shining into houses.

There was discussion relative to safety and the speed study required in order to request the State's approval to reduce the speed limit.

There was discussion relative to the desire for the County Engineer to meet with Mrs. Roader and other area residents to consider the viability of their desire to realign the connection of Red Lion Five Points Road with Bunnell Hill Road.

Phil Mullin, area resident, stated his opinion that the residents are not in favor of the proposed roundabout at Lytle Five Points and Bunnell Hill Road.

Dominique Roeder, area resident and Springboro High School student, discussed the danger of the roadway to both school buses and cars and requested the Board take out the existing house in order to improve the site distance and improve safety.

Upon further discussion, it was determined that the County Engineer will discuss the design suggestions from the residents with the project design engineer and schedule a time on a future Commissioners' Agenda.

Upon motion the meeting was adjourned.
