DISCUSSIONS

On motion, upon unanimous call of the roll, the Board accepted and approved the consent agenda.

Susanne Mason, Program Manager within the Office of Grants Administration, was present for a follow-up work session to discuss and select five projects for funding with the FY 2023 Community Development Block Grant allocation.

Mrs. Mason stated she has filled in the public service amounts to be awarded based upon the previous work session. She stated that they have received the allocation amount from HUD and the Board has \$642,388 to allocation to no more than 5 construction projects.

The Board discussed the various project and upon final determination, selected the following:
