**Gulley Park** near Ft. Ancient has a newly constructed trail looping through a mature mixed hardwood forest. The woods is a favorite of many species of local woodpeckers, as well as deer, squirrels and raccoons and other small mammals. The nut-bearing trees produce good crops of acorns, hickory nuts and beechnuts which are food staples for many birds and animals. Interpretive signs along the 1.65-mile trail loop provide information about the historical usage of the land as well as plant and animal species living in the park today. **Click here** to see more trail photo's in our park photo library.
